JUNIOR LEAGUE CURLING

The Junior Curling League is for young people (7 -17 years old) who wish to learn to curl or improve their skills in a fun and safe environment. The juniors meet every Tuesday from 3pm until 4:30pm. The season runs from October 29th until the end of February, but young players are welcome to join or leave at any time during the season. The Oliver Curling Club provides all the equipment needed, but we would like the juniors to come with clean runners and warm clothing as it is cold in the rink. We also encourage all young curlers to wear helmets on the ice (e.g., bike or hockey helmet). A drink and snack are provided prior to going onto the ice.



Coaches offer training for beginners who have never been on the ice before right up to the competitive level. It is not only about training: juniors have fun playing various curling games each week and are able to participate in Junior Bonspiels with juniors from different clubs. Once curlers reach a certain level, they can also curl in the evening leagues or join a competitive junior team if they wish.

The total cost for the season is \$60.00. This covers the use of equipment, snacks, and the Oliver Junior Bonspiel. New junior curlers can try out two sessions for free before paying for the season. Additional costs would be out-of-town Junior Bonspiels (usually \$10 per spiel) and \$40.00 to curl in other Oliver leagues.

You can register any Tuesday from 3pm until 4:30pm (starting October 29th), by email, or at the curling rink on October 19th between 10:30 and 1:30 during our Family Fun Day event.
